Collective Worship

We have, this week, been thinking ahead to the festival of Easter. We have shared the story of The Three Trees and explored the importance of the symbol of the cross for Christians. This fitted beautifully with the last week of our Reflections Table where the children have been colouring their own crosses.

Last week we focused on Love, as part of Respect Yourself and Others; this led up to Mothering Sunday. We shared the Bible story of Solomon and a favourite of mine, The Invisible String. We talked about how we are joined to those we love, when we are with them but also when we are apart, our relationship joins us.

The children were so open to this metaphor and once again I was impressed by their deep thinking and well thought out responses to questions.
